Work Hours in the U.S.

What <u>are</u> the usual work <u>hours</u> of Americans? How do Americans spend their <u>free</u> time?

The Bureau of Labor Statistics <u>asked</u> Americans these <u>questions</u> in a **survey**. The American Time Use Survey <u>began</u> in 2003. It shows <u>how</u> Americans **spend their time**.

Rachel Krantz-Kent is program manager of the American <u>Time</u> Use Survey. She says <u>that</u> employed <u>men</u> worked, on **average**, more hours than employed <u>women</u>.

"One of the interesting things we know from the American Time Use Survey is that, on <u>average</u>, American <u>men</u> spend more time working for pay than American <u>women</u>. However, while men work more <u>hours</u> than women, we also observe that women are spending more time <u>providing</u> childcare and doing <u>household</u> work such as <u>cleaning</u> and food preparation."

Based on the 2010 <u>survey</u>, employed people work an **average** of <u>seven</u> and a <u>half</u> hours a day. Full-time male workers average 8.2 hours a <u>day</u>. Women <u>average</u> 7.8 hours a day.

<u>More</u> people work on weekdays than on <u>Saturday</u> and Sunday. 82% of employed <u>people</u> work on weekdays. 35% work on weekends.

From 2005 – 2009, over 50% of American <u>workers</u> started their jobs each day by <u>8:00</u> a.m.

The report <u>also</u> tells how Americans spend their time <u>away</u> from work. On an <u>average</u> day, nearly everyone <u>watched</u> television,

socialized, or exercised. People <u>spent</u> an average of 2.7 hours a day <u>watching</u> television.

Adults 75 years and <u>older</u> averaged 1.1 hours of reading a day on <u>weekends</u>. People between 15 and 19 years old **averaged** about <u>six</u> minutes of reading a day. People 15 – 19 years old <u>spent</u> more time playing <u>games</u> or using a computer.
